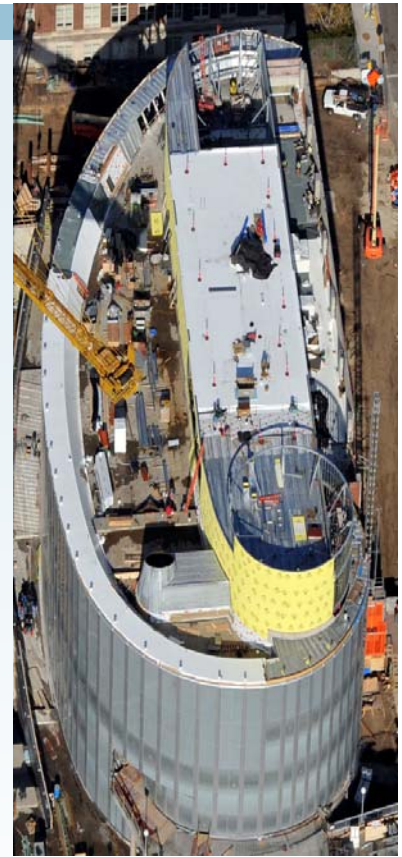

5th Annual Sporting Clay Shoot



The 5th Annual Union Sportsmen's Alliance Sporting Clay Shoot along with Roofers & Waterproofers International is being held on Saturday, September 12, 2015 at Wild Marsh Sporting Clay in Clear Lake, MN.

This event is open free of charge to Local 96 members. Even if you don't own a gun, one can be provided to you or you can bring your own.

Last year Local 96 set a record for the most number of shooters at a USA Clay Shoot event with 203 shooters. Let's beat that record with even more shooters.

Registration begins at 7:30am. Shotgun start at 9:30am. Lunch and prizes will be awarded after the shoot.

Teams will consist of five shooters. Call the office to register your team or call on your own and we will place you on a team.

The 4th Annual Kids Sporting Clay Shoot will be held the next day on Sunday, September 13, 2015 at Wild Marsh Sporting Clay in Clear Lake. The event runs from 9:00am—12:00. Lunch will be provided.

Back to School Time!

Metro Area Apprenticeship School begins the week of October 19th.

Phase 1 classes will be held on either Monday or Tuesday. Phase 2 classes will be held on Wednesday or Thursday. Phase 3 classes will be held on Friday's.

Apprenticeship School is a total of 144 hours (18 days) per year. Invitations will be mailed the week of September 7th. If you feel you should be invited and do not receive an invitation, feel free to contact the Apprenticeship Office at 763-230-7675.

*Failure to attend and complete school will result in an apprentice being unindentured. Meaning you will not be eligible to work on certified payroll jobs and your wages could be frozen until you are indentured again.

Certification Opportunities

OSHA 30 Certification: Mondays & Tuesdays from October 19th & 20th - November 16th & 17th (*All five days are required to obtain card) - If you lost your card and it has been longer than three years you must retake the class.

Flagging Card: October 19 or 20th

Competent Person/Fall Protection: October 26 or 27th AND November 2 or 3rd

Rigging & Signaling: November 9 or 10th

Hazardous Communication: November 16 or 17th
